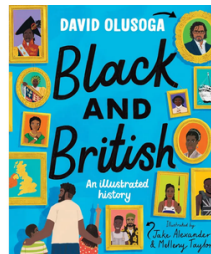
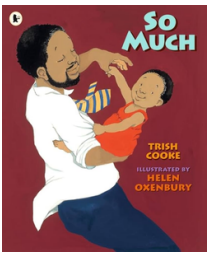


Chawson's Reading Round-up

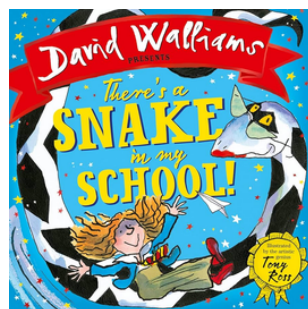
The Giving Tree by Shel Silverstein
