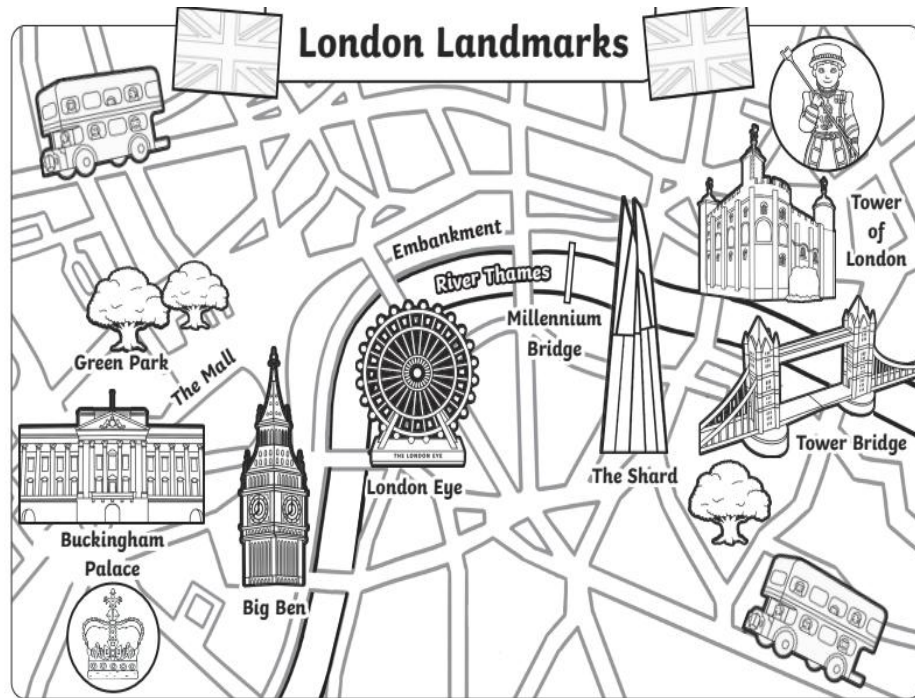


We will be exploring London, using Google Earth, photographs and maps, to find out where the landmarks are. We will be able to label their locations and discuss how we might travel to them.



During our computing lessons, we will be using the computers to safely research facts about Buckingham Palace, The Houses of Parliament, The Tower of London and Tower Bridge.

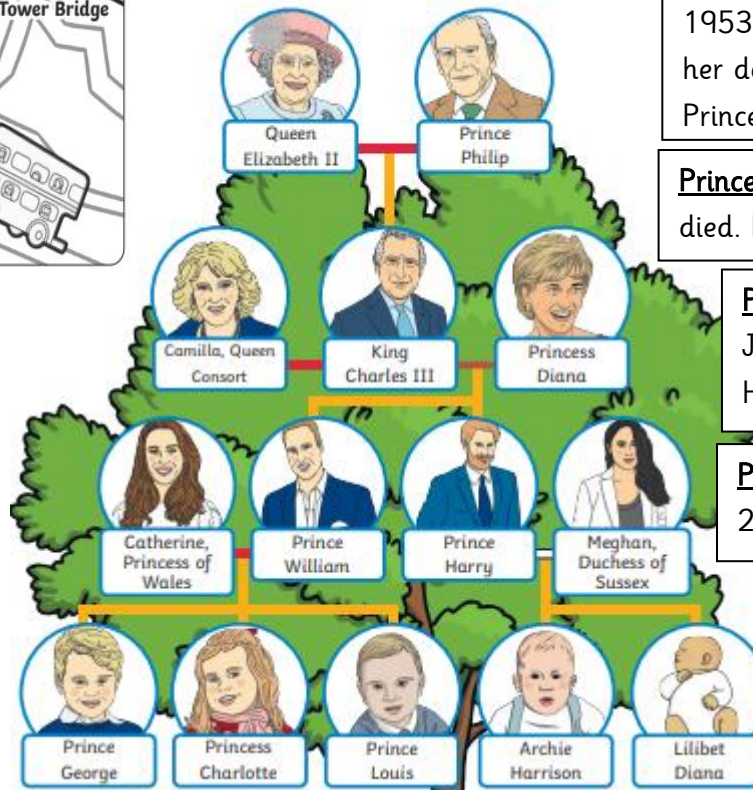

Key Vocabulary:

- Landmark**- a natural or man made feature that is used to find your way around a place. It stands out from an environment and can often be seen from a long distance.
- Capital city** is a city that is stated as the main city by law or the government. Capitals are normally the largest city in the region.
- Transport**- is the movement of humans or animals from one place to another. People can travel in London by; bike, bus, train (including the underground), boat, bike, tram, river bus or taxi.
- Tourist** is a person that visits a place for pleasure or interest.

The Royal Family is made up of King Charles and his immediate close relatives who support him in completing the royal duties.

Elizabeth was crowned Queen on the 2nd June 1953 in Westminster Abbey. She reigned until her death on 8th September 2022. Her husband Prince Philip, died on 9th April 2021.

Prince Charles became King after Queen Elizabeth died. He was coronated on 6th May 2023.

Prince Charles married Princess Diana 29th July 1981. She died on 31st August 1997. He married Camilla on 9th April 2005.

Prince William married Kate Middleton on 29th April 2011.

Prince Harry married Meghan Markle on 19th May 2018.
